Any plant can upset your dog's stomach, but the toxic ones can create severe symptoms like intense vomiting, organ damage or death. It depends on the plant, the size of your dog and how much your dog ingests. Always seek veterinary advice if you think your dog is having a reaction to a plant as it can be fatal if left untreated. Signs of toxicity are excessive salivation, vomiting, lethargy, rapid breathing, irregular pulse or cold extremities.
